

The first half of the trip will be the week of August 29th. During this time we will set up and host another yard sale at the Torreon Navajo Mission on September 3rd. We will stay and work at the mission as well as attend worship with them.

#### We will be collecting the following donations for the yard sale:

Blankets, sheets, bedspreads, jackets/coats/sweaters, pots/pans, small kitchen appliances, towels, tools, auto supplies, small furniture, bikes, beds/good mattresses, dishes and curtains/shades/rods. Please make arrangements to drop off items or have items picked up no later than August 21st.

The second half of the trip can be tagged with the first half or it can be entirely separate trip. This one will be go from September 4-12, and will be a firewood cutting/splitting/hauling trip.

#### **Sunday Mornings:**


- Nursery is available for ages 0-3 during worship.
