I (Pastor Brad) have been posting some devotions, scriptures and thoughts on our Lighthouse Facebook Page since the pandemic began in March 2020. You can find them <u>here</u>. An Active or Passive Faith?

We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised (Hebrews 6:12).

I have always been intrigued by the dual nature of faith: it is, as the writer of Hebrews describes it in this verse, simultaneously <u>active</u>: *do not become lazy*; and <u>passive</u>: *through*...*patience inherit what has been promised*.

And then he gives us examples to follow: but imitate those who... In v.13 he references Abraham. OK. So how do we imitate Abraham? And later he references many saints of old in Hebrews 11, often called the Hall of Faith by believers down through the ages. OK. So how do we imitate them? (Hopefully not by being sawed in two! Hebrews 11:37)

We certainly can see both activity and passivity in the life of Abraham – sometimes in the same story. After receiving the promise of a son, but unable to bear him a child, his wife Sarah convinced him to take matters into his own hands; so he slept with her servant, Hagar, and Hagar bore him a son, Ishmael. This story, as told in Genesis 16, is an example of Abraham doing a poor job of being passive – he could (and should) have

disagreed with Sarah's suggestion, as well as a poor job of being *active* – he went ahead and slept with Hagar.

From this story it may seem like Abraham completely messed up the unfolding of the promise, and that maybe we should imitate someone else's example. But Paul helps us see the bigger picture of Abraham's faith: ²⁰ Yet he (Abraham) did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, ²¹ being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised (Romans 4:20-21).

Abraham made lots of mistakes, not just this one with Sarah, Hagar and Ishmael. In that sense, he is no different than us. But Abraham had at least four things going for him:

- He did not waver through unbelief
- He was strengthened in his faith
- He gave glory to God
- He was fully persuaded God would come through

So which of these phrases would you consider active

faith on the part of Abraham, and which would you call *passive*?


At first glance I might say that three of the four are active on the part of Abraham: the only passive phrase seems to be that *he was strengthened in his faith*; this phraseology makes it sound like an outside force had helped him (which is, of course, true).

When Paul wrote in Romans 4 about Abraham, he was looking back over his whole life, not just one part, or a few parts of it. There were plenty of years when he, like Noah, like Moses, like Joseph, like most of the saints we read about, simply had to wait with patience on God to act.

Yet all throughout those years, Abraham sought after God with all his heart and obeyed him to the best of

his ability. When he was told to move, he moved; when told to stay, he stayed.

Like Abraham, let us continue trusting ourselves fully to God, both actively confessing our beliefs and serving him by serving others, and wait patiently for him to bring about his perfect will in us, around us and through us.



Our Vision



- To grow in Christ and become like Him.

Twice a year (Fall & Spring), a mid-week Family Night and Kingdom Kids is offered on Wednesday evenings that includes a meal, family worship, and Bible study activities for all ages. Dates, times, and other necessary information will be provided in the weeks prior to each session.

Special Events:

- Vacation Bible School for ages Preschool-5th grade is offered each Summer. Dates and details is provided each Spring.
- Seasonal Family Events (onsite, online, or at-home) occur throughout the year. *Info* is provided in the weeks prior to each event.
