

The Genius of Generosity

Kansas pastor Jack Wellman has been credited with the insight that there is a certain genius in generosity. He explains that when we open our hands figuratively speaking to allow something to pass through our fingers, rather than holding it with tightly clenched fists, God can give us new blessings.

God cannot pour more into hands that are already clinging tightly to what they hold, says Wellman. Whether material goods or time, ideas or talents, money or energy, the gifts God has given us so generously are to be shared just as freely with others. With our hands continually open to receive, give and receive again, God's genius cycle of generosity goes on and on.



Intentional Generosity

Typically I ride my bike to the south from where I live, since I enjoy riding in the country much more than the city. But a fellow cyclist friend showed me a good bike path that takes us over into Missouri and connects with the Trolley Track Trail along Wornall. From there we rode all the way to the Liberty Memorial.

My friend Dave mentioned several times how many homeless people he has seen along the bike path in KCMO, and on that day we saw a couple of men and women. That got us talking about homelessness in general and ways that we can help people in that situation.

Which gave me an idea.

A week or two later we decided to make the same journey, so I loaded some non-perishable foods in my backpack and encouraged Dave to bring some food as well. Along our route we stopped three different times to bless homeless people with the food we had brought along on our ride.

Being intentional about blessing people with generosity turned a routine bike ride into more of a mission. No longer worried about typical things, like speed or mileage, we continually surveyed the area for someone we could encourage on that day. I even "knocked on the door" of a tent located just off the pathway. So when the man unzipped the door, I gave him some food and said, *God bless you, my friend*.

Over and over again God calls us to be generous in our love to others. Most of us truly want to obey this command which Jesus modeled for us, but wonder why it so often slips away.

The key, as with most of life, is to <u>be intentional</u>. Take some time to pray and think about who and how you can bless someone – a neighbor, a co-worker, the mail carrier, the person behind you in line at a store, the car behind you in the Drive-Thru Lane. And then open your eyes to the people and needs around you as you go about your everyday life.

Michele and I pack ziplock bags in our cars and look for homeless people who are waiting at stoplights in various spots. Be creative with your kindness and love, but be intentional about doing it; otherwise it will end up as just another good intention, but helpful to no one.

But just as you excel in everything – in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us – see that you also excel in this grace of giving. 2 Corinthians 8:7

Each worship service includes a Family 5 time during the Children's Message which teaches a simple Biblical truth and engages believers of all ages!



I (Pastor Brad) have been posting some devotions, scriptures and thoughts on our Lighthouse Facebook Page since the pandemic began in March. You can find them <u>here</u>. My Mother, the Pilot

My mother absolutely hated to fly, so most of her life she didn't. One of the few times she did I had the *pleasure* of sitting next to her for a long flight to San Francisco. For three solid hours she squirmed and groaned, jerking with the air pockets, unable to keep her mind off her misery. At one point I looked down at her hands – her white knuckles gripping the armrests in a continual battle to pull up, push down, and moved them side to side – it looked like a sincere attempt to dismantle the plastic from the metal. So I asked her, "Mom, what are you doing?" She turned and looked at me with her eyes wide open and said, mirthfully, "I'm steering the plane!"



Well, after all, someone had to.

We all have things in our world that we try to control, but simply cannot. How about you? What do you try to control, even though you know in your mind that it doesn't work? It's not a bad question to ask yourself, especially during this pandemic: Which things happening around me do I *have* control of, and which things are *beyond* my control?

This is both a spiritual and an emotional issue for us. And when it comes to the things I cannot control, it becomes a matter of trust. Will I trust God, that he is sovereign over all? If we truly believe that he is sovereign, that all things are ultimately under his

direction, then we can experience *his peace that passes understanding* (Phil.4:7). But if we keep fighting to steer a plane even though we'll never get near the cockpit, well, that will keep you up most of the night in a never-ending cycle of frustration.

It has helped me to learn, and then convince myself, that I need to focus on those things that I *can* change, and *release* those that I cannot. Maybe the following list can help you:

Things I Cannot Control:

- The actions of others or how they react
- Predicting what will/will not happen
- ♦ How long the pandemic will last
- Other people's motives
- Will there be college football (yikes!)
- ♦ And the list goes on...

These are the things that we have to learn to let go and entrust them to the Lord...yes, even your beloved college football or eating out at your favorite restaurant.

Things I Can Control:

- My positive attitude
- Limiting my social media
- Finding things to do at home
- Turning off the news
- Reading the Bible
- Praying on a daily basis
- Reaching out to others with God's grace

So focus on the areas of your life that you *can* control; ask the Lord to help you grow in his grace; and ask him to help you let go of what you cannot change.
