

At this time we are looking for volunteers during the collection week as well as loading trailers on the final day, Monday, November 22nd.

Volunteer During Collection Week (Nov. 15-22)

- November 15-19 (Mon-Fri) from 9:00am-4:00pm, we will begin accepting shoeboxes that have been assembled for children around the world. We want to allow people to either bring their boxes into the Church building or have someone come and pick up boxes from their cars. To accomplish this, we will need 2-3 helpers per day.
- We also will accept shoeboxes on Saturday, November 20th from 10:00am-2:00pm and on Sunday, November 21st from 11:30am-2:00pm.
- Then on *Monday, November 22nd from 9:00am-3:00pm*, other drop-off centers will bring in their shipping boxes to be loaded onto large trucks located in our parking lot. We will need volunteers throughout the day who are able to lift heavy boxes.

- Seasonal Family Events (onsite, online, or at-home) occur throughout the year. Info is provided in the weeks prior to each event.
