Camp Rules

- **NO** boys in girl cabins. **NO** girls in boy cabins.
- Do **NOT** bring alcohol, tobacco products, or fireworks.
- Cell phones and iPods will be accepted, but if these privileges are abused, the electronics will be taken for the remainder of the time.
- All shorts and skirts should come almost to your fingertips when your arms are at your side 3.5 inch inseam. Be tasteful, we encourage modesty (as well as Windermere)
 - ❖ **These rules will be enforced, and if your students have nothing appropriate to wear, you will have to come pick them up.**
- “The 3 B’s” must be covered at all times. Ladies – if you aren’t sure if it’s modest, it probably isn’t. Do not leave it up to Windermere or Lighthouse to decide.
- Girls two-piece swimsuits that show the stomach are **not allowed** (Windermere enforces this)
- Everyone needs toiletries (**esp. deodorant**)
- You will **NOT** need towels or bedding (unless beds fill up and we will discuss this at that time)
- Your student must have 2 current medical forms on file. If you are unsure whether you have this and that they are current, please ask Elias Wedde, Harbor Youth Director.
 - ❖ **Your student must have a camp medical form**
 - ❖ **Your student must have a Lighthouse medical form on file**
- Quiet hours for the camp are from 11pm-7am. You must respect those hours because you may have people above you or below you in your bunk. You must also stay in your own cabins during these hours.
- No camper will be permitted to leave the campgrounds.
- Please tell your cabin leader when you take any medications. We need to know this if there is any emergency.
- Treat leaders, other campers, and property with respect.
- **DO** bring squirt guns, board games, decks of cards, balls, Frisbees, etc.
