Shema: Listen, hear, or hear and do

Shema Prayer:

Hear, O Israel, the L-rd is our G-d, the L-rd is One.

Blessed be the name of the glory of His kingdom forever and ever.

You shall love the L-rd your G-d with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your might. These words which I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them thoroughly to your children, and you shall speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road, when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign upon your arm, and they shall be for a reminder between your eyes. You shall write them upon the doorposts of your house and upon your gates.





The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, Because the Lord has anointed me To bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to captives And freedom to prisoners; Ísaiah 61:1

- 6. List all the ways the producers show us that Jesus was human like us.
- 7. Smart men lack wisdom. How does Jesus both honor and challenge things that the children are learning from those who are teaching them?
- 8. Where were you yesterday? Jesus: There was a woman who needed my help.
- 9. What is your reason for being here? How does Jesus answer Abigail?
- 10. How are we to have the faith of a child? How do children see differently than adults?


