- Carpentry, masonry and building things

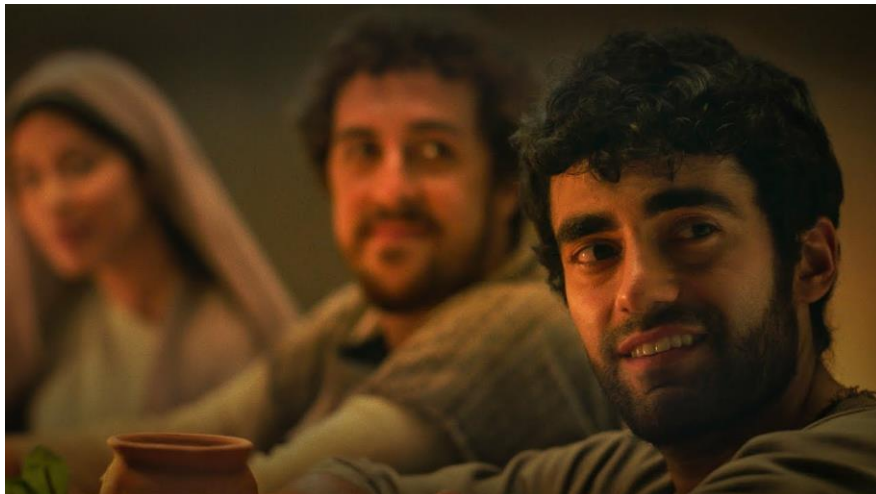
What other themes or ideas did you pick up as you watched Episode 5?

Activities to help families connect with and reflect on *The Chosen* together.

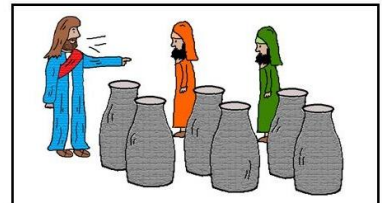
Color the wonderful miracle when Jesus changed water into wine!
