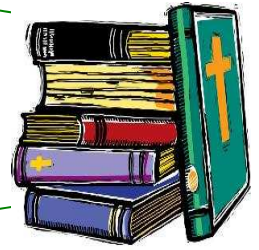

We have also celebrated births, baptisms, and the wedding of Stephanie and James Willis. Of course, Stephanie works in our nursery and CDO. We have celebrated the addition of new church staff, with Cali Eck and Matt Miller serving at New Hope in official capacities.

Unfortunately, this has also been a year of sadness. I conducted the funeral services of two church members, Jean Callaway and Yvonne Harris, early in the year. I have also conducted two services of family members of church members and Cali Eck conducted another. The last week of July I ministered to the family of Stewart Haught, who has served New Hope well as our sound technician. Stewart was a blessing to me and to our church and we will miss him. As I reflect on what we have experienced in 2011, I know that God is good and that God is at work to do good in and through this congregation. We still have much to do. In the next few months there will be two VIM trips, Missions Sunday, the Health Fair, and many other opportunities for discipleship, worship, and service. Let us continue to be faithful as we serve the Lord who loves us and blesses us!

**Study opportunities** (continued from page 1) These are all long-term studies. Costs for books range from \$15 to \$40.

*Disciple I* will begin on August 21. David Salter will be teaching this overview of the Bible. Participants will read approximately 65% of the Bible during the 34-week course. Sessions will be held Sundays from 4:30 until 6:30.

*Disciple II* "into the word into the world" will be taught by Cindy Hill on Sunday evenings from 4:30 - 6:30. This course is for those who have completed Disciple I. It also begins August 21.

*Companions in Christ* class also meets on Sundays at 4:30 and will be taught by J.D. Ward. This will not begin until August 28.

*Disciple III* will meet on Thursday evenings from 6:30 until 8:30. It is taught by Cali Eck and begins August 25.

A ten-week Beth Moore study class, "*Believing God*" will be led by Amy Aita beginning September 13. It will be Tuesday evenings at 6:30 p.m.

There will be short-term (6-8 week) classes taught on Wednesday nights beginning in September. Details should be available in the September Supplement that will come out then.

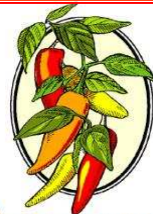

And so it is with life. What we see when watching others depends on the pureness of the "windows" through which we're looking. Is your sight clean and pure?

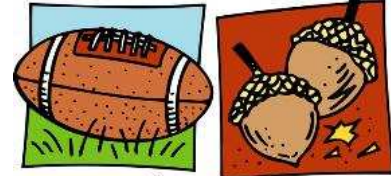
