

 - Similar to a Savings account
 - Money collected through the years and available to be spent as needed
 - It helps smooth out irregular cash flows and provides financial flexibility


- Key Messages:

 - Christian Education Coordinator
 - Raises for Rector and Staff
 - Communications funds
 - Increase Sexton hours
 - Budget deficit of \$57k to be funded by the Uncommitted Reserve and Gordon bequest
