Our Founding Father

On May 7th every church year we commemorate the life and ministry of Carl Ferdinand Wilhelm Walther (1811 – 1887), the father of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod. C.F.W. Walther emigrated from Saxony, Germany, with other Lutherans in 1839 and settled in Perry County, Missouri (approximately two hours south of present day St. Louis).

Walther served as pastor of several congregations in St. Louis, founded Concordia Seminary in 1839 (which was later moved to St. Louis in 1849), and in 1847 was instrumental in the formation of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (then called the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio, and Other States).

Pastor Walther served as the Synod's first president from 1847 to 1850 and again from 1864 to 1878. He worked tirelessly to promote confessional Lutheran teaching and doctrinal agreement among all Lutherans in the United States. Walther was a prolific writer and public speaker, and among his most influential works are *Church and Ministry* and *The Proper Distinction Between Law and Gospel*.

O Lord, the light of minds that know You, the life of souls that love You, and the strength of the hearts that serve You, give us strength to follow the example of Your servant C.F.W. Walther, so that knowing You we may truly love You and loving You we may fully serve You—for to serve You is perfect freedom; through Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Ben was eighty years old. He was in great shape for his age. Until fifteen years ago he had worked very hard, establishing his own business. The Lord blessed that effort with great value in that business. Upon retirement, it was time for Ben to enjoy more recreation time. He lined up four different groups with whom to golf throughout the week. His wife and he loved to gather with family and friends. In their new busy schedule of retirement, there was little energy left to review their estate plan.

Ben had always said that 25% of his assets, except for the house, would be a gift to their congregation. Eventually, Ben agreed to meet with an LCMS Gift Planning Counselor and discovered that all his financial accounts were directed by beneficiary designations that would give 100% to his wife or 100% to their son. Since the will directed that their house be given to their son, and 100% of their financial accounts would be going to their son, what was left was about \$3,500 in the checking account that would be controlled by the gifting language of their will. This successful businessman was going to give a \$750 gift to his church.

That was not what Ben wanted at all! This realization moved him to put down the golf clubs for one day to work on his plans. After items were updated, Ben commented that he was really at peace knowing that their plan was secure and in place. He rejoiced in the gift that would be going to ministry.
