

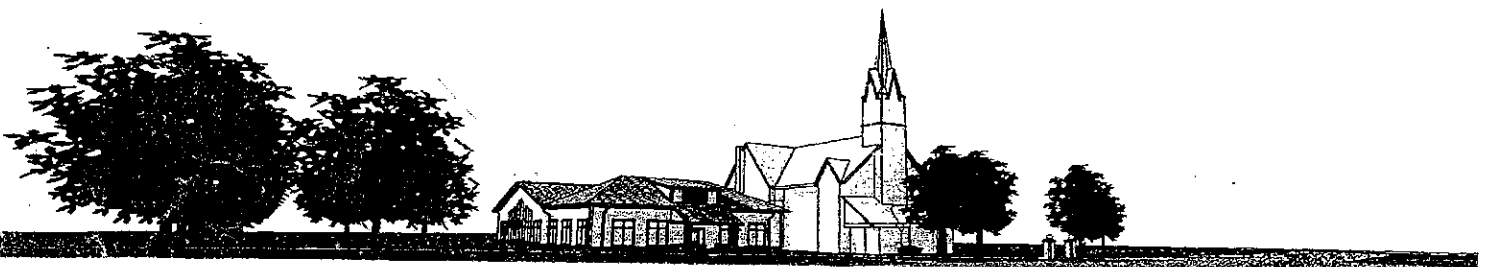
*Off Duty for God until Fall:*

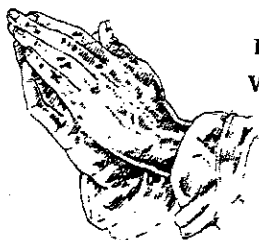

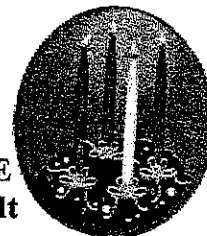

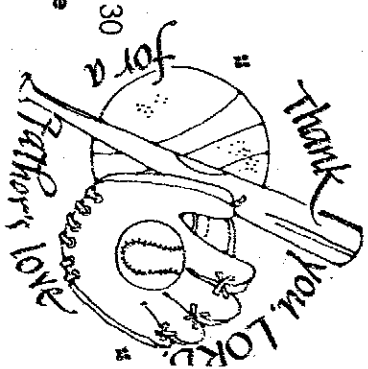
