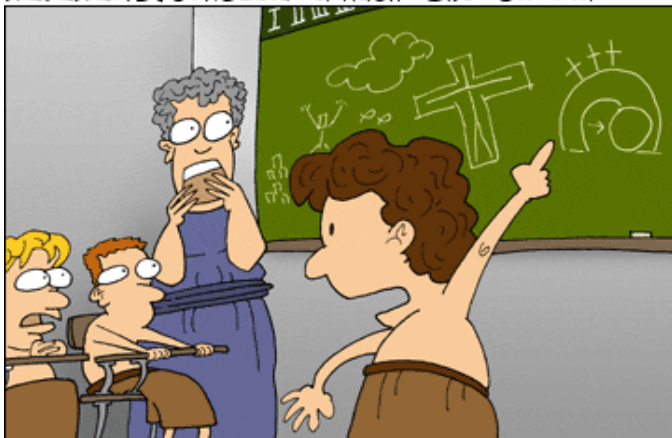
SUNDAY SCHOOL

We will necessarily need several adults over the age of 25 as chaperones for this event. These chaperones would need to be willing to drive rental vans and fully participate in all aspects of the event. Camp Restore is a hurricane relief servant event that will provide numerous opportunities for construction opportunities, environmental projects, and human care.
