Sign-up for the **2019 National Lutheran Youth Gathering** in Minneapolis, MN is nearing the very end! Theme for the once – every – three - year gathering will be **“Real.Present.God.”**. Dates for this event are July 11-15, 2019.....but our group will be leaving from church in the late evening of Monday, July 8, 2019 and return in the evening of Monday, July 15, 2019. Side trips will include one night at Lutheran Island Camp in West-central Minnesota, a trip to Mall of America, and downtown experiences right before the Gathering begins.

Registration, nationwide, is expected to be anywhere between 25,000-30,000 participants. Deacon needs the names of those who will attend the Gathering by THIS SUNDAY. Deposits of **\$ 125.00 per participant** will be due as well as a completed registration form. Trying to be added to the roster at a later date will be a little difficult and a lot more expensive.
