Gr. 5: We all, like sheep, have gone astray; each of us has turned to his own way. **Isaiah 53:6**

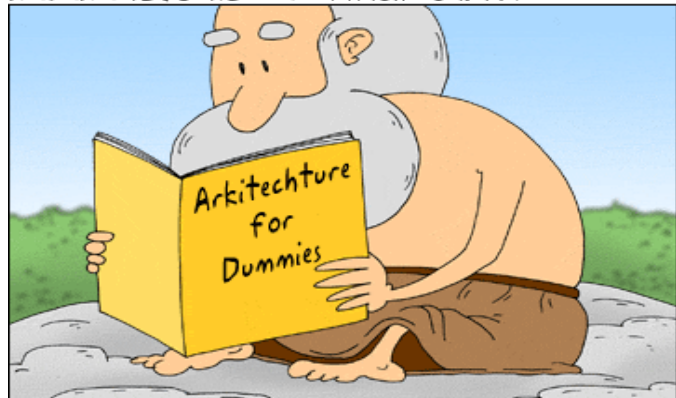
