

## CLC Weekday School - 3rd Grade - Lesson & Memory Work

- 8-22 Lesson 1: **Creation**  
I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made: Your works are wonderful, I know that full well. Psalm 139:14  
Books of the Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, 1 Chronicles, 2 Chronicles
- 8-29 Lesson 2: **The Fall**  
I am God Almighty; walk before Me and be blameless. Genesis 17:1  
Books of the Bible: Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel
- 9-5 Lesson 3: **The Tower of Babel**  
Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up. James 4:10  
Books of the Bible: Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi
- 9-12 Lesson 4: **God Makes Abraham's Faith Stronger**  
Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. Proverbs 3:5  
Books of the Bible: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Acts, Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians.
- 9-19 Lesson 5: **God Frees His People**  
Everyone who sins is a slave to sin...the Son sets you free. John 8:34-35  
Books of the Bible: 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, Jude, Revelation
- 9-26 Lesson 6: **The Ten Commandments**  
Through the law we become conscious of sin. Romans 3:20  
First Commandment and meaning: You shall have no other gods. What does this mean? We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.
- 10-3 Lesson 7: **The Golden Calf**  
Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. Matthew 22:37  
Second Commandment and meaning: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
- 10-10 Lesson 8: **The Birth and Call of Samuel**  
Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it. Luke 11:28  
Third Commandment and meaning: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.
- 10-17 Lesson 9: **David and Goliath**  
He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways. Psalm 91:11  
Fourth Commandment and meaning: Honor your father and your mother. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.
- 10-24 Lesson 10: **Saul and the Witch of Endor**  
Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor Me. Psalm 50:15  
The Fifth Commandment and meaning: You shall not murder. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.
- 11-7 Lesson 11: **God's Promise to David / David's Prayer**  
How great You are, Lord! There is no one like You, and there is no God but You. 2 Samuel 7:22  
Sixth Commandment and meaning: You shall not commit adultery. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.
- 11-14 Lesson 12: **David and Bathsheba**  
If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins. 1 John 1:9  
Seventh Commandment and meaning: You shall not steal. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.
- 11-28 Lesson 13: **Psalms**  
Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Corinthians 15:57  
Eighth Commandment and meaning: You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest possible way.

- 12-5 Lesson 14: **Solomon's Receives Wisdom**  
The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge. Proverbs 1:7  
Ninth Commandment and meaning: You shall not covet your neighbor's house. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it
- 12-12 Lesson 15: **Solomon Builds the Temple**  
Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker. Psalm 95:6  
Tenth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant, or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.
- 12-19 Lesson 16: **Naboth's Vineyard**  
There is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents. Luke 15:10  
Tenth Commandment and meaning: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant, or maidservant, his ox or his donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
- 1-9 Lesson 17: **God Calls Jeremiah**  
Before I formed you in the womb I knew you. Before you were born I set you apart; I chose you to be a prophet of the nations. Jeremiah 1:5  
The Creed - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Article: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.
- 1-16 Lesson 18: **John the Baptizer Prepares the Way**  
Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for Him. Luke 3:4b  
The Creed - 3<sup>rd</sup> Article: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
- 1-23 Lesson 19: **God Fulfills His Promise**  
Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom His favor rests. Luke 2:14  
The Lord's Prayer - The Introduction and meaning: Our Father who art in heaven. What does this mean? With these words God tenderly invites us to believe that He is our true Father and that we are His true children, so that with all boldness and confidence we may ask Him as dear children ask their dear father.
- 1-30 Lesson 20: **The Boy Jesus in the Temple**  
I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You. Psalm 119:11  
The Lord's Prayer - 1<sup>st</sup> Petition and meaning: Hallowed by Thy name. What does this mean? God's name is certainly holy in itself, but we pray in this petition that it may be kept holy among us also.
- 2-6 Lesson 21: **Jesus Teaches Nicodemus**  
For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. John 3:17  
The Lord's Prayer - 2<sup>nd</sup> Petition and meaning: Thy kingdom come. What does this mean? The kingdom of God certainly comes by itself without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may come to us also.
- 2-13 Lesson 22: **The Parable of the Lost Son**  
All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23  
The Lord's Prayer - 3<sup>rd</sup> Petition and meaning: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. What does this mean? The good and gracious will of God is done even without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may be done among us also.
- 2-20 Lesson 23: **The Call of the Disciples**  
For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16  
The Lord's Prayer - 4<sup>th</sup> Petition and meaning: Give us this day our daily bread. What does this mean? God certainly gives daily bread to everyone without our prayers, even to all evil people, but we pray in this petition that God would lead us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.
- 2-27 Lesson 24: **Zacchaeus**  
For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost. Luke 19:10  
The Lord's Prayer - 5<sup>th</sup> Petition and part of the meaning: And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. What does this mean? We pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would not look at our sins, or deny our prayer because of them.
- 3-6 Lesson 25: **Jesus Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem**  
Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the King of Israel! John 12:13  
The Lord's Prayer - 5<sup>th</sup> Petition and the meaning: And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. What does this mean? We pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would not look at our sins, or deny our prayer because of them. We are neither worthy of the things for which we pray, nor have we deserved them, but we ask that He would give them all to us by grace, for we daily sin much and surely deserve nothing but punishment. So we too will sincerely forgive and gladly do good to those who sin against us.

- 3-13 Lesson 26: **Jesus Washed His Disciples' Feet**  
 The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:45  
 The Lord's Prayer – The 6<sup>th</sup> Petition and first part of the meaning: And lead us not into temptation. What does this mean? God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us...
- 3-27 Lesson 27: **The Last Supper**  
 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes. 1 Corinthians 11:26  
 The Lord's Prayer - The 6<sup>th</sup> Petition and meaning: And lead us not into temptation. What does this mean? God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us or mislead us into false belief, despair, and other great shame and vice. Although we are attacked by these things, we pray that we may finally overcome them and win the victory.
- 4-3 Lesson 28: **Peter Denies Jesus**  
 If anyone would come after Me, He must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me. Luke 9:23  
 The Lord's Prayer - 7<sup>th</sup> Petition and first part of the meaning: But deliver us from evil. What does this mean? We pray in this petition, in summary, that our Father in heaven would rescue us from every evil of body and soul, possessions and reputation...
- 4-10 Lesson 29: **Jesus Before Pilate and Herod**  
 Jesus answered..."From now on, the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the mighty God." Luke 22:67-69  
 The Lord's Prayer - 7<sup>th</sup> Petition and the meaning: But deliver us from evil. What does this mean? We pray in this petition, in summary, that our Father in heaven would rescue us from every evil of body and soul, possessions and reputation, and finally, when our last hour comes, give us a blessed end, and graciously take us from the valley of sorrow to Himself in heaven.
- 4-24 Lesson 30: **The Crucifixion**  
 But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8  
 The Lord's Prayer – The Conclusion and first part of the meaning: For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen. What does this mean? This means that I should be certain that these petitions are pleasing to our Father in heaven...
- 5-1 Lesson 31: **The Resurrection**  
 (Jesus said,) "I am the resurrection and the life, He who believes in Me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in Me will never die." John 11:25-26  
 The Lord's Prayer – The Conclusion and the meaning: For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen. What does this mean? This means that I should be certain that these petitions are pleasing to our Father in heaven, and are heard by Him; for He Himself has commanded us to pray in this way and has promised to hear us. Amen, amen, means, "yes, yes, it shall be so."
- 5-8 Lesson 32: **The Pentecost**  
 But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all truth. John 16:13
- 5-15 **Movie Night**
