### CONFERENCE PERSONALITIES




#### Dr. Kelly Jones, Pastor of First Baptist Church, Harrisburg, AR

- Zach is a passionate worship leader who will help us get our hearts prepared each session for what God has in store for us.




#### Dr. Danny and Rhonda Sinquefield, Pastor of Faith Baptist Church, Bartlett, TN
