



THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT CAMP!

- **DEPARTURE/RETURN:** We will leave **Monday, July 25th PROMPTLY at 8:00 a.m.** (load-up around 7:30) and we plan to be back home **Friday, July 27th between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. PLEASE!** Make sure your child has their **lunch money for Monday** with them (not in their suitcase) for the trip to Siloam.
- **DRESS CODE: CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO REFLECT A CHRISTIAN EXAMPLE BY THEIR DRESS. MINISTERS AND DORM SUPERVISORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DRESS/APPEARANCE OF THEIR YOUTH.** Shorts (not shorter than the tips of the camper's fingers with their arms extended toward their knees) are acceptable in all services. Undergarments should **NOT** show under or over clothing. Midriffs should **NOT** show. Halter-tops and shirt/dress straps less than an inch wide are **NOT** allowed. Message T-shirts featuring rock music groups, alcohol, tobacco products, or inappropriate or suggestive statements are **NOT** allowed. Hats or caps will **NOT** be worn in the worship center.
- **SWIMMING POOL:** *One piece swim suits ONLY*
- **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP:** Guns, knives, fireworks, pets, tobacco products, alcohol, music players, handheld gaming devices, roller skates, skateboards, scooters, ATV's, motorcycles and bicycles.
- **ITEMS NEEDED FOR CAMP:** Bible, pen/pencil, pillow, linens (*beds are twin size bunk beds; sleeping bag or sheets will work*), towels, personal items, toiletries, extra pair of shoes, and money.
- **MONEY**
 - **THE HUB:** If a camper wants to buy any items from The Hub, he/she must purchase a CROBSTER CASH CARD. **CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR PURCHASES AT THE HUB SNACK BAR.** Crobster Cash Cards may be purchased for \$5 each. Camp souvenirs, T-shirts, toiletries, gifts, etc. are available for purchase at "The Hub." T-shirt costs range from \$8.00 to \$20.00. **ONLY CASH OR CREDIT CARD WILL BE ACCEPTED IN THE HUB SOUVENIR STORE.**
 - **VERY IMPORTANT:** We HIGHLY RECOMMEND the following system to be utilized by parents to ensure the proper use of their child's money. In the past, many of the kids spent all of their money before the first day was over. Ok, so that's a bit of an exaggeration. Anyway, to ensure that your child has money for the meal on the way and on the way back, and money for purchases at THE HUB while at camp, please consider this system:
 - Give Bro. Kelly or Mrs. Holly one envelope or ziplock bag for EACH of these (one for The Hub each day):
 1. Money for Lunch on the way to Camp (**PLEASE DO NOT PACK THIS MONEY**)
 2. Daily Money for The Hub (Ex: Monday \$5, Tuesday, \$5, etc.)
 3. Money for t-shirts, souvenirs, and other "extra" things.
 4. Money for Lunch on the way home. (Many kids ran out of money in years past and we had to pay for their lunch—not gonna happen this year! They will starve before we pay! JK!!!)
 - So that's one envelope for Monday Lunch, one for each day for The Hub, one for "Extras," and one for Friday Lunch—Potential of 7 Envelopes Total.
 - We CANNOT loan money to the children if they run out. Once each day's envelope or bag is empty, they will not be allowed to spend anymore. The amount they are allowed to spend will be determined by you.
 - Suggested Amount of Money to Bring (Remember, they will be fed 3 meals a day that are included in camp cost):
 - Lunch Monday: \$7-10, The Hub: \$5 per day (4 days), Extras: \$10-20, Lunch Friday: \$7-10
 - **MAIL:** Campers can receive mail from family and friends. It usually takes 2-3 days for mail to reach the Arkansas Baptist Assembly, so send mail early. Campers should check with the Business Office during the morning break or in the afternoon to pick up their mail. Mail should be addressed to:
