

THINGS PARENTS AND MINISTERS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT CAMP!

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: Check-in begins at 1:00 pm on Monday in the dining hall. The first required meeting will begin at 4:00pm, so be sure to allow enough time for your campers to get settled in their rooms prior to the 4:00 meeting.

Friday's session is usually over and you can be on your way home by approximately 10:00am.

DRESS CODE: **CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO REFLECT A CHRISTIAN EXAMPLE BY THEIR DRESS. MINISTERS AND DORM SUPERVISORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DRESS/APPEARANCE OF THEIR YOUTH.**

Shorts (not shorter than the tips of the camper's fingers with their arms extended toward their knees) are acceptable in all services. Undergarments should **NOT** show under or over clothing. Midriffs should **NOT** show. Halter-tops and shirt/dress straps less than an inch wide are **NOT** allowed. Message T-shirts featuring rock music groups, alcohol, tobacco products, or inappropriate or suggestive statements are **NOT** allowed. Hats or caps will **NOT** be worn in the worship center.

Swimming Pool - One piece swim suits ONLY.
NO bikinis or one-pieces that resemble a bikini. (NOT EVEN WITH A T-SHIRT OVER IT!)

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP: Guns, knives, fireworks, pets, tobacco products, alcohol, radios, tape players, CD players, iPods, MP3 players, roller skates, skateboards, scooters, ATV's, motorcycles and bicycles.

ITEMS NEEDED FOR CAMP: Bible, pen/pencil, linens, towels, personal items, toiletries, jacket, umbrella, extra pair of shoes, and money.

SNACK SHACK: If a camper wants to buy any items from the Snack Shack, he/she must purchase a SNACK SHACK CARD. **CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR PURCHASES AT THE SNACK SHACK.** Snack Shack Cards may be purchased for \$5 each. Any unused amounts on SNACK SHACK CARDS may be redeemed on Friday before leaving camp. (APPROXIMATE PRICES: popcorn - \$.50, candy - \$.75, sno-cones - \$.75, drinks - \$1.00, ice cream - \$1.25, hot dogs - \$1.50, nachos - \$1.50, Juleps - \$1.50)

BOOK STORE: Camp souvenirs, T-shirts, toiletries, gifts, etc. are available for purchase at the camp Book Store. T-shirt costs range from \$8.00 to \$20.00. **(ONLY cash, credit cards or church checks will be accepted.)**

NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

FIRST AID STATION: A registered nurse or paramedic will be on duty at the First Aid Station. They are on call anytime in case of an emergency. A schedule for routine medications will be announced for each week. All cases of sickness or injury should be reported to the First Aid Station. Health regulations REQUIRE all registered campers to submit a completed medical form (*part of the registration form*) when they attend SILOAM. Campers on regular medication must leave all medications at the First Aid Station to be administered by a nurse.

SCHEDULES: For a copy of the schedule go to www.ilovesiloam.net. You will receive a printed copy with your first invoice.

MEALS: All meals are served in Hatfield Hall. Bread and peanut butter are available on the tables at all meals.

Breakfast: A hot breakfast is served in the two center lines, and a cold breakfast is served in the left line.

Lunch and Supper: A hot meal is served in the two center lines, hotdogs and/or hamburgers are served in the left line, and a salad bar is available in the right line.

MAIL AND TELEPHONES: Campers can receive mail from family and friends. It usually takes 2-3 days for mail to reach the Arkansas Baptist Assembly, so send mail early. Campers should check with the Business Office during the morning break or in the afternoon to pick up their mail.
