Sunday, May 27, 2018

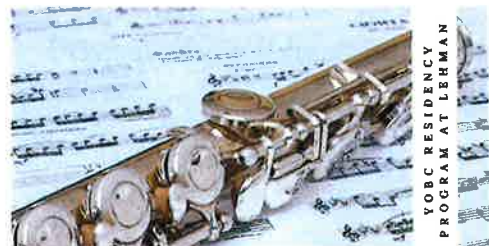
