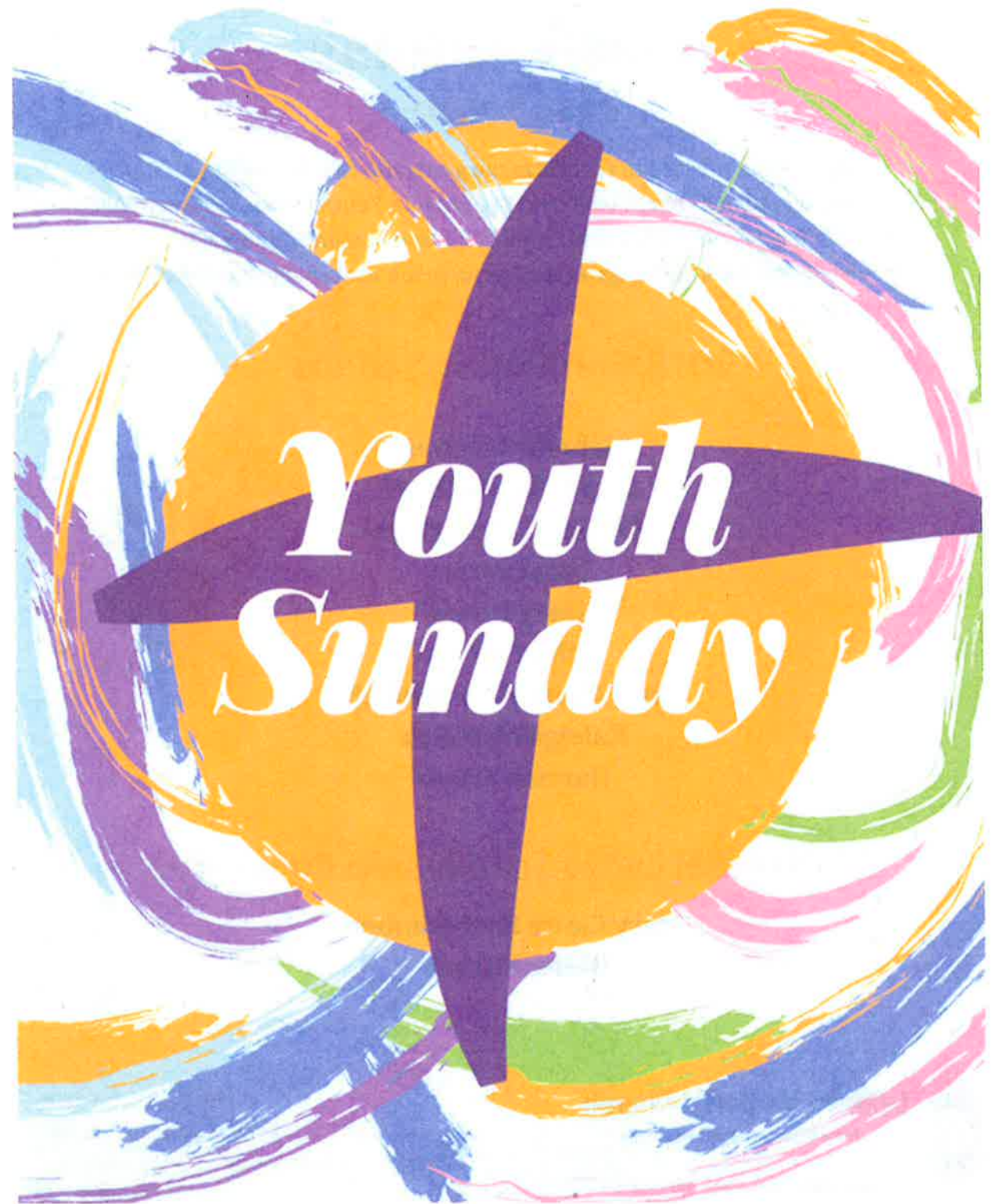

The Isabel Lyttle Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 1993 at Lehman Church. Through this scholarship, the purchase of books and necessary school supplies is available to graduating seniors pursuing further education.

Isabel Lyttle was a graduate of Upper Moreland High School and West Chester State Teachers College (now West Chester University). She taught first grade in the Upper Moreland School District for over 45 years! Ms. Lyttle was a member of Lehman Memorial Church for 63 years. She was head of the Beginners (pre-schoolers) Sunday School Department, where she was not only responsible for the department, but taught a Sunday School class as well.

Isabel Lyttle never tired of teaching. She was active in the United Methodist Women where she served on the administrative board, and after retiring, she taught lessons for some of the Women's Circles. Ms. Lyttle also found time to volunteer with Meals-On-Wheels, Lenten Luncheons, Bible School and the choir's Ham Dinners. She ordered all lesson materials for the Sunday School and was a member of Crooked Billet Woman. Isabel loved her God and her church and would be very proud and honored that this scholarship, established in her memory, be used to aid college students in furthering their education.
