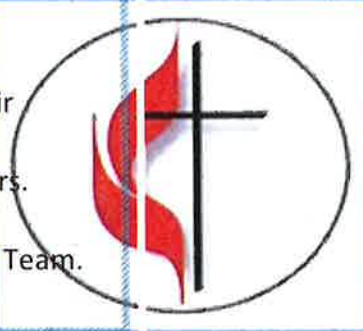

Philippians 1:21-30

²¹ For to me, living means living for Christ,
and dying is even better. ²² But if I live, I
can do more fruitful work for Christ. So I
really don't know which is better. ²³ I'm
torn between two desires: I long to go and
be with Christ, which would be far better
for me. ²⁴ But for your sakes, it is better
that I continue to live.

²⁵ Knowing this, I am convinced that I will
remain alive so I can continue to help all of
you grow and experience the joy of your
faith. ²⁶ And when I come to you again, you
will have even more reason to take pride
in Christ Jesus because of what he is doing
through me.

Live as Citizens of Heaven

²⁷ Above all, you must live as citizens of
heaven, conducting yourselves in a
manner worthy of the Good News about
Christ. Then, whether I come and see you
again or only hear about you, I will know
that you are standing together with one
spirit and one purpose, fighting together
for the faith, which is the Good
News. ²⁸ Don't be intimidated in any way
by your enemies. This will be a sign to
them that they are going to be destroyed,
but that you are going to be saved, even by
God himself. ²⁹ For you have been given
not only the privilege of trusting in Christ
but also the privilege of suffering for
him. ³⁰ We are in this struggle together.
You have seen my struggle in the past, and
you know that I am still in the midst of it.
