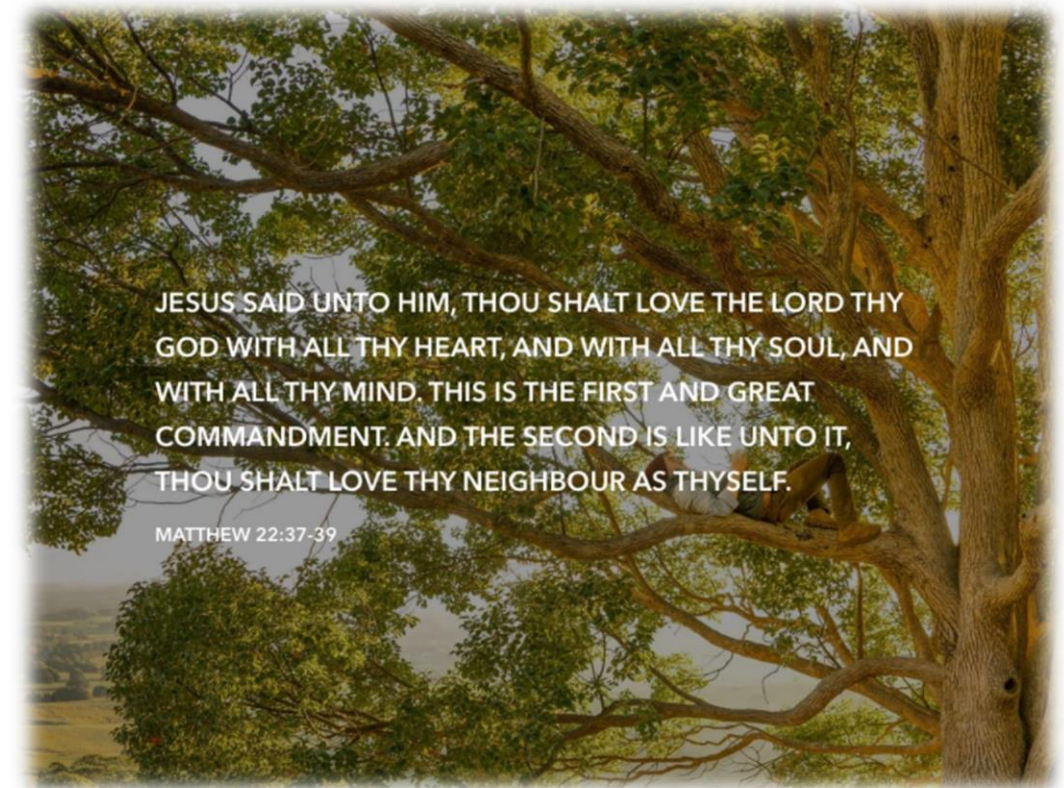
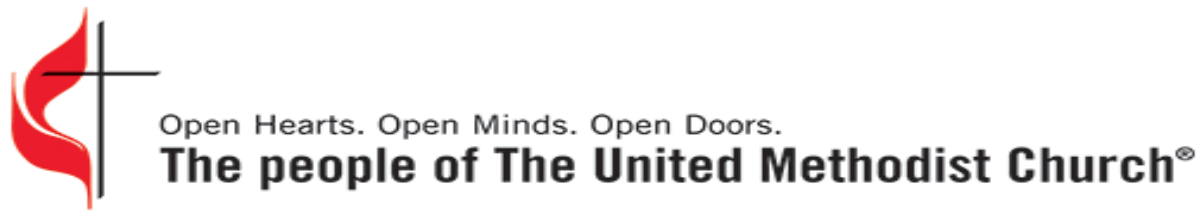

Charge Conference will be held at 1:00 p.m. at New Hope.

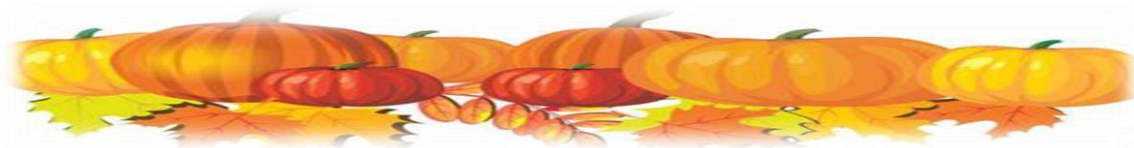
