WELCOME NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS

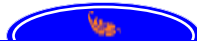
- We of St. John's welcome you and invite you to become part of our parish.

Stephen Ministry Training: Session Five— Process versus Results in Caregiving

Please pray for our Stephen Ministers as they continue to enhance their caregiving skills. Here is what they are learning this week.

If ever there were a time for Stephen Minister trainees to say “Aha!” this module would be it. They learn the key understanding that they don’t have to (and indeed can’t) fix whatever problem it is that their care receiver faces. This session is a time for a collective sigh of relief. God is the **curegiver**; the Stephen Minister is the caregiver. This establishment of roles is what makes Stephen Ministry possible. The concept runs counter to the strong results-oriented approaches of present-day society. But in caregiving, the more one pushes for results in another, the faster and farther they flee.
