Stephen Ministry Training: Session Four— Distinctively Christian Caring

Please pray for our Stephen Ministers as they continue to enhance their caregiving skills. Here is what they are learning this week.

Stephen Ministers explore the essentials of using their Christian faith in caring for another, drawing on the resources of prayer, witnessing, the Bible, forgiveness, blessings, and more. An important motto of Stephen Ministry is “The Stephen Minister is the caregiver, and God is the curegiver.” This underscores the Christ-centered focus for Stephen Ministers. They will also explore how Christian caregivers have something distinctive that they can offer that other caregivers cannot provide—God’s unconditional love and forgiveness through Jesus Christ. Our Stephen Ministers will specifically practice and discuss the use of prayer, confession and absolution, and the Bible in caregiving relationships.
