I love the way the Apostle Paul wrote about the Resurrection of Christ:

"Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you were saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

*For what I received I passed on to you as of **first** [emphasis mine] importance: that Christ died **for our sins according to the Scriptures**, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day **according to the Scriptures**, and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all of the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born" (1 Corinthians 15:1-8 NIV).*

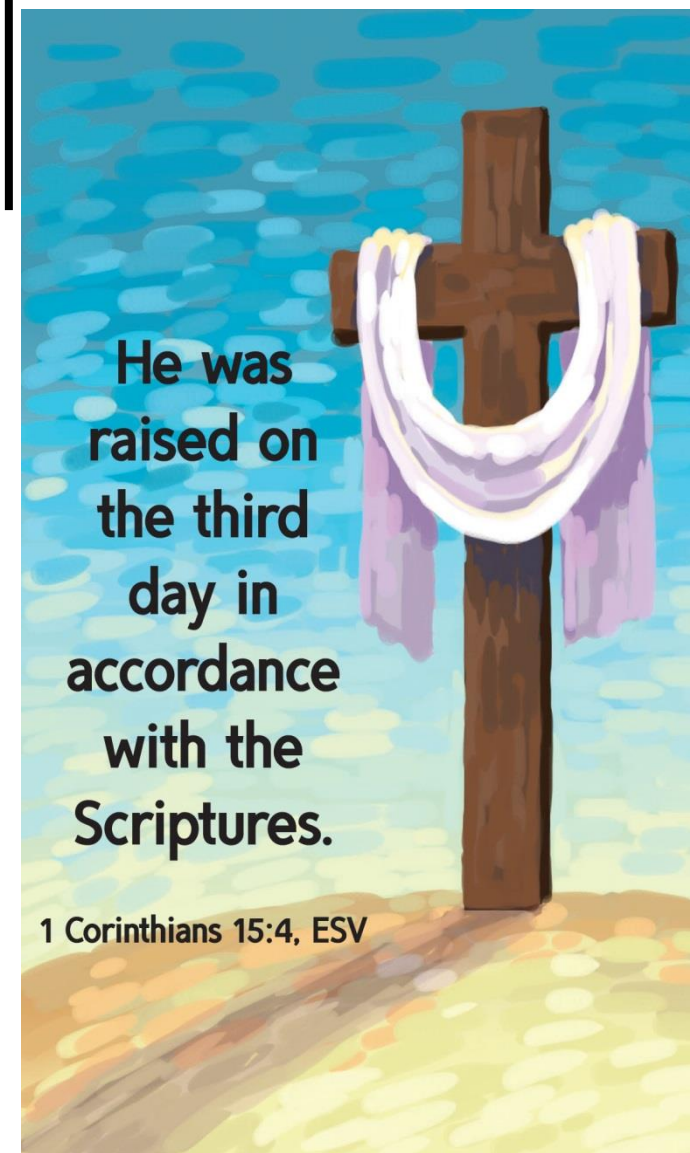
Then he continues in verse 10, *"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them – yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me."*

Easter is about grace – God's grace shown to us through Jesus, His only Son, and our only Savior. In verse 57 of 1 Corinthians 15, Paul sums it all up perfectly, *"But thanks be to God! He gave us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."* **AMEN!!!**
