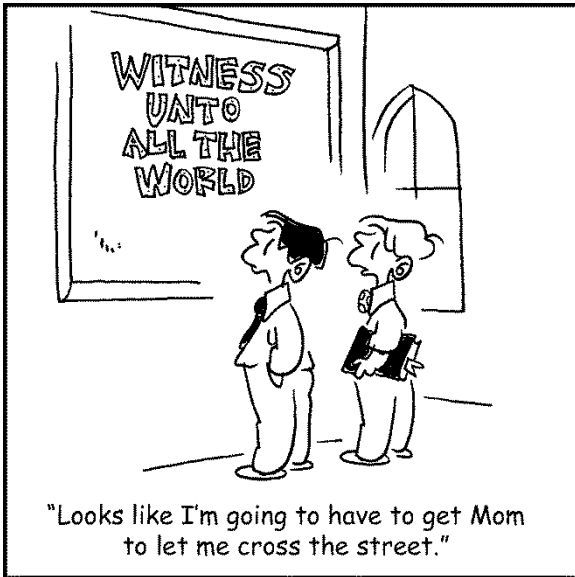

Attendance and Offering Report

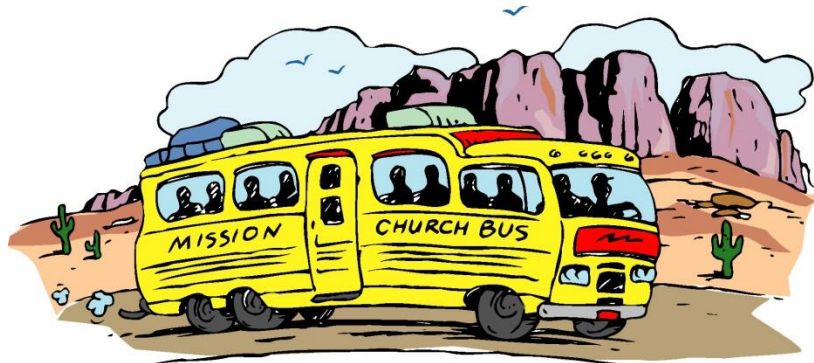
Worship Attendance Average (May): 55
