Summer Bible Study led by Pastor Dan will begin this Wed. July 9. Everyone is invited to a Wednesday evening Bible Study, using the study book, *Dare to Dream: Creating a God-Sized Mission Statement for Your Life*. This study book was written by Mike Slaughter, a United Methodist pastor in Ohio. We’ll meet from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Each week will include a video segment and discussion of the Bible passage related to the evening’s theme. The Scriptures focus on the life of Jacob & Moses. Suggested donation for the study book is \$12. This study is written for people of all ages—from senior citizens, to middle-aged folk, to young parents, to youth... Topics include:

July 9: Dare to Dream - *Wake up to God's dream inside you.* (Genesis 28: 10-13)

July 16: Discover Your Identity - *You were created with a purpose.* (Ephesians 4: 11-13)

July 23: Your Burning Bush - *Be aware of those illuminating God moments in your life.* (Exodus 3: 4-6)

July 30: Lose Your Big Buts - *Allow God's strength to be displayed in your weakness.* (Exodus 3: 11-12)

Aug. 13: What's in Your Hand ? - *Identify & utilize the ordinary gifts God has given you.* (Exodus 4: 2-5)

Aug. 20: God's Dream - *Discover a dream for your life far greater than your own.* (Matthew 6: 22-24)
