Summer Bible Study led by Pastor Dan. Everyone is invited to a Wednesday evening Bible Study, using the study book, *Dare to Dream: Creating a God-Sized Mission Statement for Your Life*. This study book was written by Mike Slaughter, a United Methodist pastor in Ohio. We'll meet from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Each week will include a video segment and discussion of the Bible passage related to the evening's theme. Topics include:
