John Wesley was the founder of the United Methodist Church. Do you ever wonder what he believed? What made his preaching and church leadership unique? This study by a United Methodist pastor focuses on the key facets of his theology and their meaning for us and for our church today. Each evening includes a 10-minute video from a different place in England that was important in John Wesley’s life.
