Shimmering red/blue for the flames of the burning bush,
when God appeared to Moses.

A Summer Bible Study led by Pastor Dan is being held on Tuesday evenings, 7:00-8:30 p.m. We are discussing the book, *Revival: Faith as Wesley Lived It* by Adam Hamilton. John Wesley was the founder of the United Methodist Church. Do you ever wonder what he believed? What made his preaching and church leadership unique? This study by a United Methodist pastor focuses on the key facets of his theology and their meaning for us and for our church today. Each evening includes a 10-minute video from a different place in England that was important in John Wesley’s life. (Child care is offered, if needed; please let Pastor Dan know ahead of time if you would like child care, so he can plan for it.) Topics include:

Tues. Aug. 4: A Crisis of Faith (Romans 4: 3-5; 5: 1-2a)

Tues. Aug. 11: The Necessity of Grace (Ephesians 2: 8-10)

Tues. Aug. 18: Works of Mercy (James 2: 14-18; Ephesians 2: 8-10)

Tues. Aug. 25: Persevering to the End (Matthew 5: 10-12; Proverbs 31: 8-9)
