Our Fall schedule is underway! Each week, children (ages 3 through grade 5) are invited to attend J4J (Joyful for Jesus Sunday School). Kids leave with the teachers after the song which follows the "Time for Young Christians." **Parents, please sign out your children in the downstairs classroom (Chapel Room)** at the end of the worship service (approximately 11:30 a.m.). Throughout the school year, J4J focuses on a Bible topic for 4-6 weeks, using a variety of learning activities, such as storytelling, crafts, and cooking. This Fall's lessons will focus cover the beginning of the Old Testament: God's creation of the world, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob & Esau.
