A new look for the worship bulletin — The Worship and Worship Enhancement teams are trying out a new design for the worship bulletin. To the left of the lamb is a chalice receiving the blood Christ poured out in offering himself as a living

sacrifice. The compass rose, skewed slightly clockwise, reminds us that when the world seems disoriented, the Christ of our faith remains true. Let us know what you think of the new look.
