Pastor Anne has called a special church council meeting on **Monday, October 23, 2017 at 7 pm**, for the sole purpose of hearing a presentation by UMC' Pastor Jack Ruth on "The Family Promise Ministry". This Ministry focuses on alleviating homelessness in our local community. Family Promise is asking us to be a host site which entails,

our church housing overnight, up to three screened families for a week at a time (from suppertime until the morning), four weeks out of the calendar year. We would be responsible to provide dinner and a separate sleeping quarters for each family. After the presentation, ample time will be offered to ask questions and raise concerns. Then the voting Church Council Members present, will vote by paper ballot, to decide on behalf of our church, if they will allow this Non-Profit Ministry, to utilize our church building, as a mission outreach program of our North Rose UMC. Please know, Pastor Anne will fully support the outcome of whatever our Church Council majority agrees to. All are encouraged to check out Family Promise Ministries in advance of our council meeting, to be better informed, www.fpwayne.org or www.familypromise.org. Let's keep this upcoming meeting in our prayers for our leaders' discernment. Thank you, Pastor Anne.

There will be a Training on Safe Sanctuary and our Church Mutual Insurance Safety Protocols, on **Tues., October 17 at 6 p.m.** in the fellowship hall. We ask that anyone interested in working with children, youth, vulnerable adults, church visitors, Sunday School Staff and Youth Group leaders, as well as Trustees, Church Council Leaders, Ushers and Greeters try to attend. We will be discussing such items as what to do in the event of a serious medical emergency, how to evacuate the church in case of a fire, hostile intruder, or other emergency situation, where our parishioners should seek safety and shelter, and where parents may pick up their children if we evacuate them. Our Emergency plans and updated Safe Sanctuary Policy will need to be formulated into a written policy that will be approved at our upcoming, November 8 Church Council Meeting. Everyone is most welcomed and encouraged to attend to give their input. Deb Bussard and Pastor Anne will be updating The Safe Sanctuary Policy for the Church Council's approval.
