**"The Epiphany Angel Tree Project"**. Epiphany is a liturgical season in The Church to reach out to those outside The Christian Faith or estranged from the Christian Faith. This Epiphany Season, January 7, 2018 - February 11, 2018, our church will be doing "An Epiphany Angel Tree Project." I am asking each member of our church to do three intentional acts of kindness. We will offer others three intentional acts of kindness, not just to imitate the three gifts The Wise Men gave at Epiphany, but as Christians to demonstrate Jesus as our Bridge to our Father in Heaven. Our goal in doing three kind intentional actions for those outside the Christian Faith or doubting/estranged from our Christian Faith, is to fulfill Jesus teaching in Matthew 5:16 "In the same way, let your light shine before others, so they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in Heaven." How will our "Epiphany Angel Tree Project," work? There's a Christmas Tree in the back of the church with small paper angels on them. Please take one for yourself. I am asking that you return the angel with the date(s) you performed three kind gestures to others on the angels, by Feb. 11. Some suggested deeds of kindness: Pray this Epiphany Season for three people, who do not have The Peace of Christ in their hearts; help someone with a house chore, shovel their sidewalk; make a donation to a refugee program or storm victim program; call, write or e-mail someone who is alone or grieving, questioning God's love for them. Do whatever The Holy Spirit is leading you to do, for anyone who is outside of our Faith or estranged

from our Faith. Then on **Feb. 11, "Transfiguration Sunday"**, we will celebrate how Jesus' closest Disciples saw Jesus' true Glory as The Son of God. Jesus' countenance became radiant white that day on the mountain. On this Epiphany Transfiguration Sunday, at our church, we will come forward and hang our Epiphany Angels with the dates we performed our three good deeds. The Epiphany Angel Tree will now be in the front of the church decorated with radiant white lights. As we come forward to hang our Epiphany Angel, our prayer as Christians is that we have touched the lives of others outside our Faith, because we have shined the Light of Jesus into their Lives. May The Light and Love of Jesus shine through each of us, who have acted as messengers of God's grace.
