During this time of Lent, Holy Communion/Time for Silent Meditation will be offered in the church chapel, at 12:30 and 5:15 pm each Wednesday (through Mar. 28, except for Wed. March 21 at 5:15, due to the Worship Enhancement Meeting.) If at all possible, please let Pastor Anne know of your interest in attending Holy Communion/Book Study.

A Lenten Book Study is being held in The Chapel, Wednesdays through March 14, from 11:30 am-12:30 pm. Please join Pastor Anne, for a Study on Christian author Philip Yancey book on "Prayer". We will prayerfully reflect on such questions as: "Is God listening to me?" "Why do so many prayers seemed unanswered?" "What good is prayer, does it make any difference?" Though participants are responsible for purchasing their own book, it is not necessary for you to have to purchase a book.
