

Reopening of Wednesday Nite Kids & Teens

Starting Wednesday, September 2nd at 6:30 until 7:30
Soft Opening September 2nd & 9th, Open Classes to Community September 16th

Registration will be held online ONLY. ALL children NEED to register online prior to admission.

Nursery/Pre-K and Kindergarten -1st grade

Classes will be located in the Old Fellowship Hall

- Parents will drive through the west side of the church parking and bring children to the drop-off point at the awning. Temperatures will be checked before the student exits the vehicle and then escorted to their classroom by staff.
- Masks are encouraged for students, but not required.
- Please pick up children in this age group last if you are picking up students in both buildings.

2nd-5th Grades

Classes will be located in our Family Life Center

- Parents will turn onto Hardin Park Drive and drive around the backside building, then drop off under the new awning at the Family Life Center, pick-up direction will be the same. **TRAFFIC WILL BE ONE-WAY!**
- Temperatures will be checked prior to exiting the vehicle. Parents are not allowed to “drop-off” students.
- Masks for 4th and 5th grade students are required, and encouraged for 2nd and 3rd graders.
- Children will be escorted to their appropriate gym section until class dismissal. Social distancing will be monitored.
- Class sizes will be broken down if necessary to accommodate appropriate spacing.
- 2nd-3rd grade will meet in the classroom next to bathrooms.
- 4th -5th grade will meet in the gym or classroom next to the gym depending on size.
- Common areas, such as the gym will be partitioned off and classes will be in sections for Missions video and dismissal only.

Middle School and High School

Classes will be located in our Family Life Center

- Parents will drive around the building and then drop off under the new awning at the Family Life Center, pick-up direction will be the same.
- Older student drivers will be asked to park and check-in with staff at the door before entering the facility.
- Temperatures will be checked prior to exiting the vehicle. Parents are not allowed to “drop-off” students.
- Teens will go to their designated section and then dismissed to their appropriate class, upstairs or outside, weather permitting. Social distancing and masks will be required.

Health and Safety Information

- Temperatures will be taken. No child or staff will be able to enter with a fever of 100.4 or higher
- Masks will be required for volunteers and children 4-12th grade. Masks for K-3rd and Preschool are recommended, but not required.
- Weekly temperature and attendance logs will be kept of all children/staff.
- **IF your child develops any sick symptoms we ask that you notify the church office (870) 247-1980 or Heather Amerson (870) 329-2907, immediately to report the illness.**
- Nursery is for Staff's children ONLY.
- Please do not send your child if they have experienced ANY illness (especially fever or cough) in the last 48 hours.
- Social Distancing will be implemented.
- Children will be provided with crayons/pencils, etc. for classroom use. Each child will have their own bag. These will be labeled for each student and stored in the classroom. Supplies will not be shared.
- Inside recreational activities will not be held at this time.
- Our Snack Supper will not be available at this time. All children will be offered a "Snack Bag" upon departure.
- Bottled water will be available to all students.

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We will do Virtual Check-ins on days that may be cancelled due to school or weather closings. Virtual Check-ins will consist of a group virtual meeting, such as Zoom, with a short devotional or lesson, if the student isn't available or doesn't have access to virtual lessons, check-ins will be made via phone call. Each grade level teacher will be responsible for checking in or holding a virtual lesson.

DROP OFF/PICK-UP Procedure

Drop off and Pick-up routes are the same. Please **DO NOT Park** to Drop Off or Pick-up your student (s).

Pre-K 1st Grade only students will enter Todd Lynn Drive and then turn Left after the Fellowship Hall and drop off under the Awning on the back side and exit through the main Parking Lot to Hwy 270.

Pre-K-12 grades students will enter Todd Lynn Drive, turn right onto Hardin Park Drive and follow the drive around the Family Life Center and drop off older students first under the new awning, then drop off younger students at the Fellowship Hall under the back awning and exit through the mail parking lot to Hwy 270.

2nd -12th grades will enter Todd Lynn Drive, turn right onto Hardin Park Drive and follow the drive around the Family Life Center and drop off students under the new awning and exit Todd Lynn Drive to Hwy 270.

Teen Drivers will park on the handicap side of the parking lot at the Family Life Center. Please watch for them when exiting.
