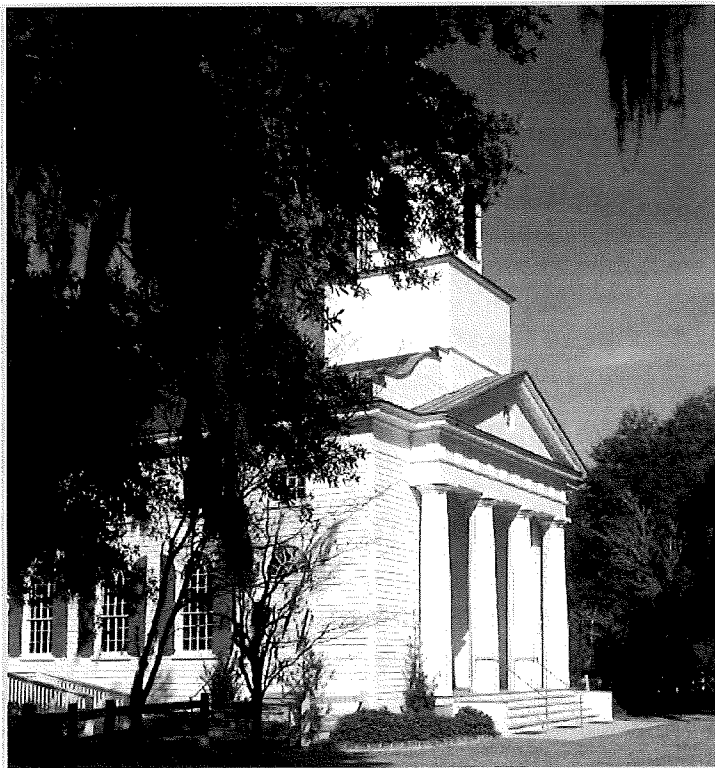

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Most Holy God, No one may see your face and live. In the light of your glory we see our frailty and our raggedness. We have good intentions but our hearts melt in the presence of adversity. Who can compare to You? Who can stand against You? Your Holiness and your majesty shines a light of judgment on our sins and our fear. When we try to live rightly we often fail. Often we do not even try. But you are a God full of mercy. Cleanse us, forgive us, set us free from our sins. Sanctify us by your Holy Spirit, that we may grow in holiness in the service of Jesus Christ our Lord . . . (Silent Confession)

We believe in one God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible;

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, Very God of Very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father by whom all things were made; who for us men, and for our salvation, came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the Virgin Mary, and was made man, and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. And we believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church. We acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins. And we look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
