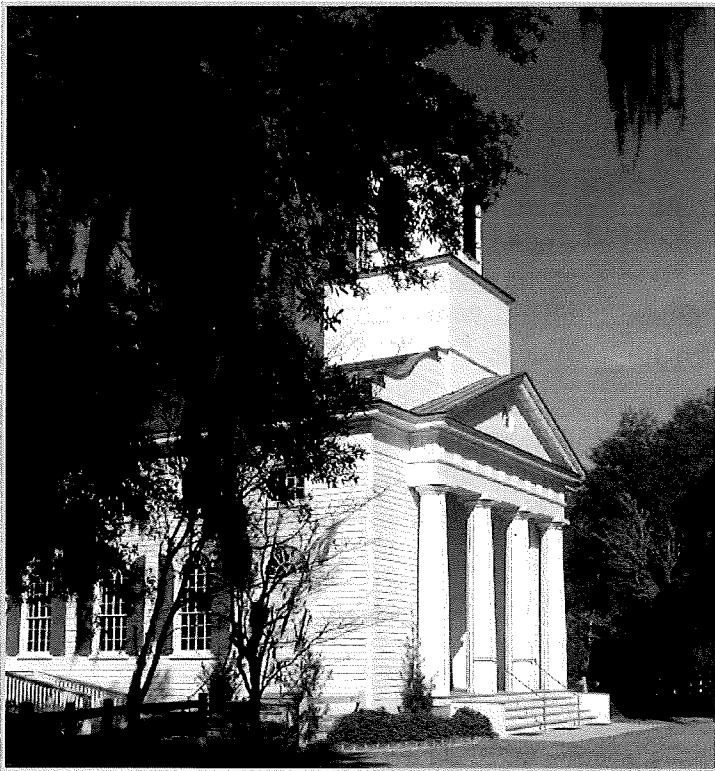

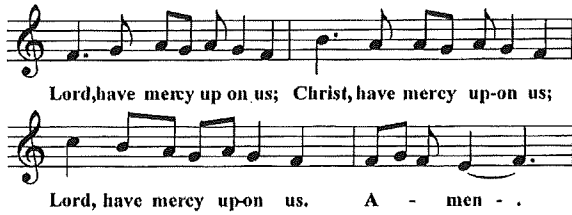

**Welcome Reverend Dr. Walter L. Taylor.** Dr. Taylor grew up in Riverdale, Georgia, just south of Atlanta. A graduate of Milligan College and Vanderbilt University Divinity School, he completed his Doctor of Ministry at Erskine Theological Seminary. His dissertation was "As They Sat Together: Presbyterian Communion Practices," in which he chronicles the history of long-table communion practices among Presbyterians. One of the chapters in his dissertation is about the continuation of this practice here at the Presbyterian Church of Edisto Island. He and his wife, Agnes, have been married for just over twenty years and have two children, a daughter Rebekah (14) and a son Iain (12). Dr. Taylor is pastor of the Oak Island Presbyterian Church, Oak Island, North Carolina, where he has served since the summer of 2007.
