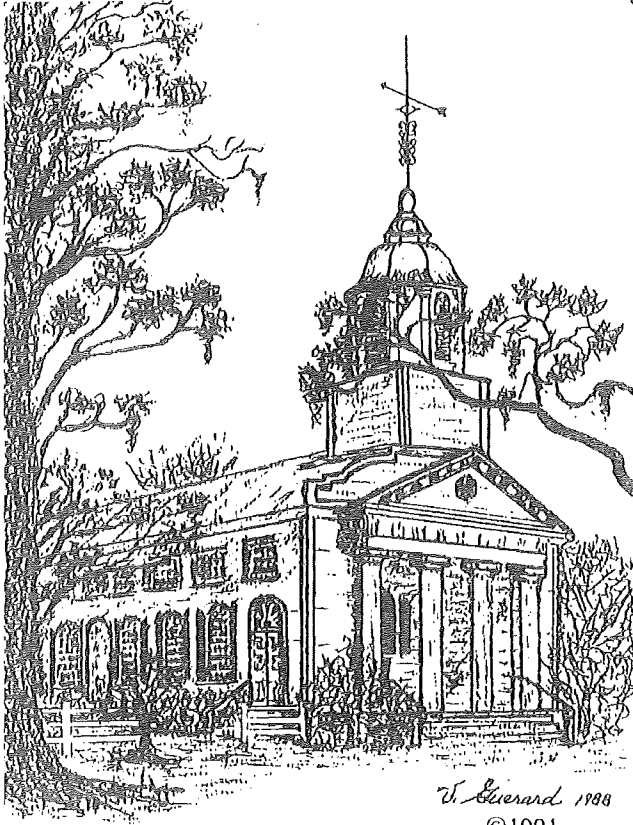

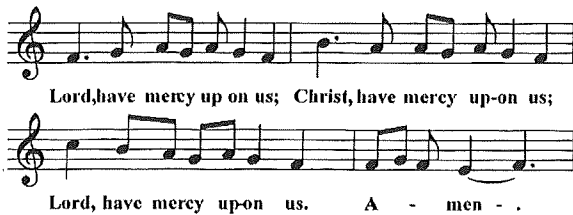

Welcome Reverend Karl Travis! Rev. Travis is Senior Pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Fort Worth, Texas. He has served at many levels across the PCUSA and on several boards including Fort Worth's Presbyterian Night Shelter, which provides emergency shelter to 600 homeless persons every night. Rev. Travis is a magna cum laude graduate of Trinity University and the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He received a Doctorate of Humane Letters from Austin College. Travis is also a Paul Harris Fellow of Rotary International. He and his wife Jacqueline parent five children.
