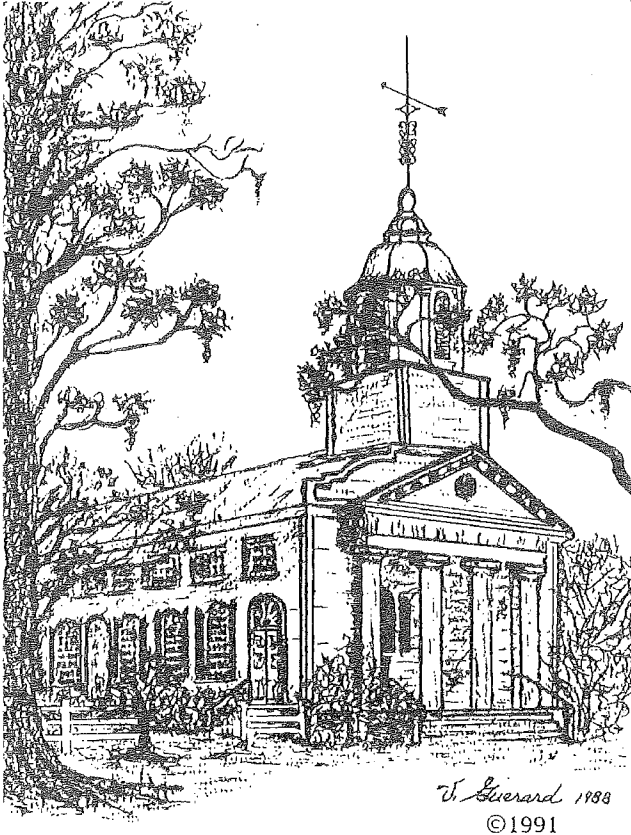

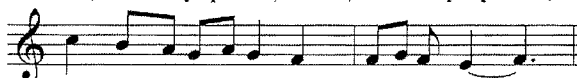
PRAYER OF CONFESSION
