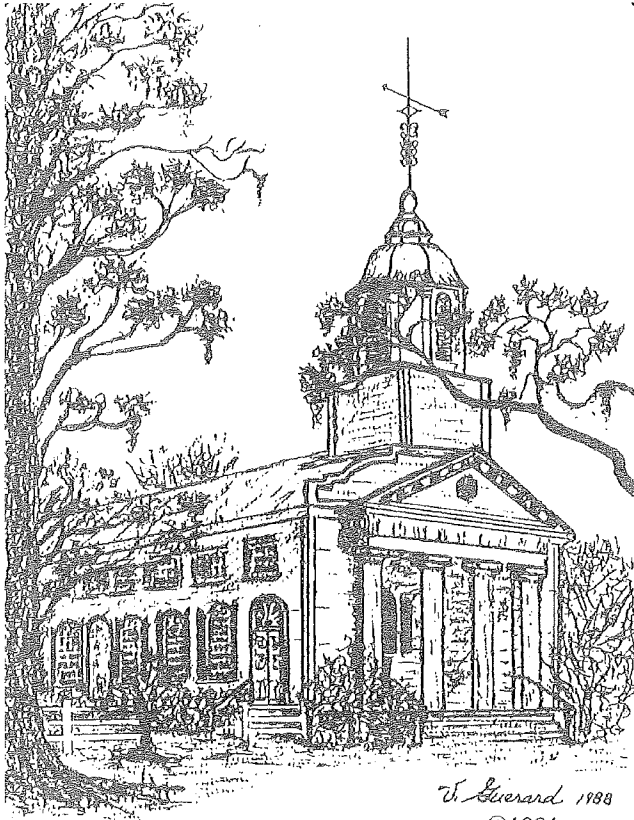

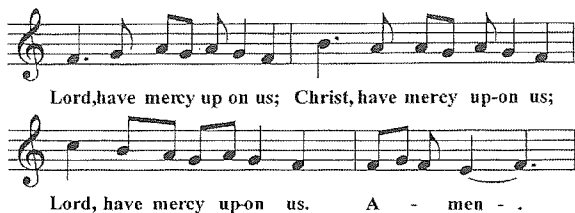

Yet, the symbol of the cross reminds us that in Christ we have been given the opportunity to cast our cares upon our Savior who forgives us and offers us life in Him in the joyous resurrection we will celebrate on Easter. Ash Wednesday is a powerful experience of participating in repentance and reconciliation. Join us for this sacred service of Ashes.
