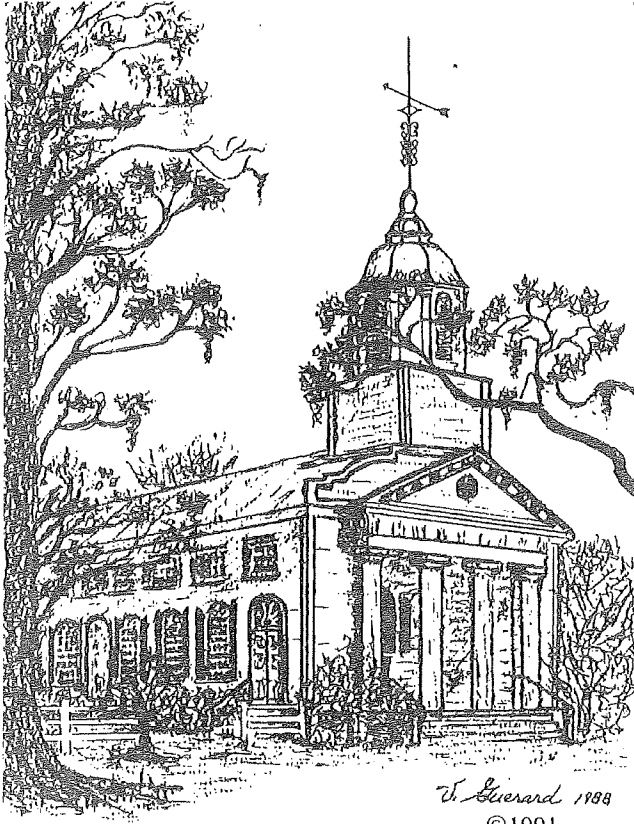

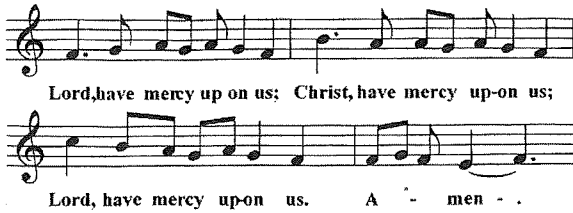

The Great Prayer of Thanksgiving
