Laurie is known for having one of the biggest and best with their Enchanted Village of Lights. Silver Dollar City also celebrates the season with over 6 million lights!

People presumably put up the lights as a decoration to reflect the joy of Christmas. Sometimes, though, the lights become a matter of competition and commercialism. Sometimes the TRUE LIGHT gets lost in all the glitter . . .

John 1.9 There was the True Light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man Psalm 119.105 Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, a light unto my path . . . then John tells us in his gospel that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us Psalm 27.1 The Lord is my light and my salvation

I John 1.5 – 7 God is light and in Him is no darkness at all

Truly our Lord is the source of all light. In Genesis there was only darkness . . . then He spoke and said, "Let there be light" and there was light! In Exodus 10 when darkness came over the whole land of Egypt for three days all the houses of Israel had light, for the Lord was their light.

Often we speak of darkness as synonymous with evil, & light as synonymous with good. In John 3.19 we read that men loved darkness rather than light for their deeds were evil. And in I John 2.8, The darkness is passing away and the True Light is already shining. As the light shines in darkness it exposes evil, and overcomes it.

David prayed in II Samuel 22.29: For Thou art my lamp O Lord And the Lord illumines my darkness

Scriptures prophesy of God coming to dwell among men using the metaphor of light coming into the world. Isaiah wrote that those living in darkness shall see a great light.

Jesus fulfills this for He is that great light! In John 8.12 Jesus said, "I am the Light of the world . . . he who follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

Let us also remember that we are to have a part in sharing that Great Light. Like a strong of lights on the Christmas tree, we are each connected to one another, and though each of individually may not give off much light, together we shine the light of the gospel for all the world to see! Let your light shine – not just at Christmas, but all through the year!




## MISSION COMMITTEE REPORT
