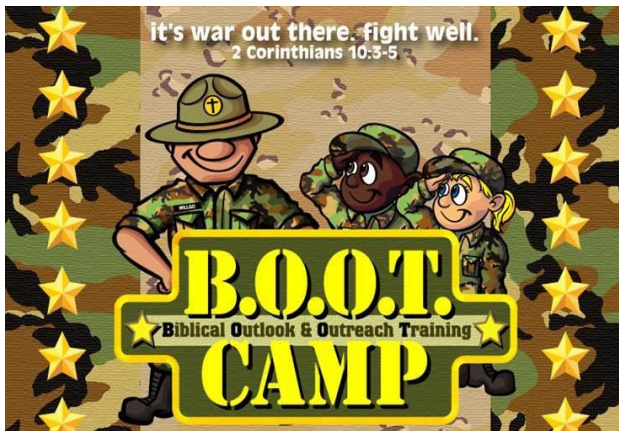

Home Depot and Lowe's Partnership

We wanted to remind you of a couple of programs that are set up to benefit the work of Southern Baptist Disaster Relief.

Lowe's and Home Depot have both partnered with the Southern Baptist Convention to offer a program that allows customers to register their personal or business cards with the program. Upon doing so, a percentage of each purchase (either in-store or online) goes directly to SBDR. There is NO COST to you as the consumer, it only requires the process of registering your card with each store, and then shopping as you normally would.

When making a purchase with a registered card, the set percentage of dollars will be matched by Home Depot or Lowe's and will go to SBDR. Those funds will then be available to state DR organizations to request funds for larger-scale state responses.

Attached are the instructions for registering your card(s) with both Home Depot and Lowes. If you know of any contractors or business leaders within your churches, feel free to pass this information along, as those larger accounts/purchases go a long way in increasing the percentage of dollars that become available to SBDR.

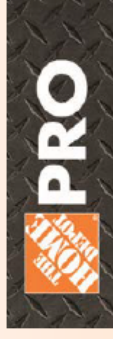
