I have seen wind farms many times — I have seen them stretching across Iowa, Indiana, northern Missouri, and on previous trips across Kansas. Each time I have seen these wind farms it has been daytime and I could see the individual windmills scattered about for miles. And in the light of day it was easy to see that each windmills seemed to be doing its own thing - I have always been curious about why some would be turning slowly, others turning more quickly, and still others would not be turning at all.

Coming across Kansas at night, recently, as Teresa and I topped a hill I saw something I had never seen before. I said "Whoa! That's awesome!" I was mesmerized. The whole horizon was light up in red light. Then darkness. Then again the whole horizon was lit up in red. The red lights at the tops of the windmills (for warning aircraft) were all blinking in sync with one another!


No longer were they individual windmills each spinning at their own speed. No indeed. Now they were all one. In unison they were blinking the message "We're here! We're here!" Apart from the energy they produced, they were letting everyone in the area know they were there. If they didn't, someone might crash into them and be hurt, or killed. I Peter 2 speaks of Jesus as a precious cornerstone – but for those who do not believe, a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense.

That is how it is supposed to be in the church – we each move at our own pace, according to our calling, but to those traveling in darkness the church should be flashing a unified message . . . "We're here! We're here!" The church is to be shining the light of the gospel, pointing others to Jesus, to Life, to freedom from guilt and sin.

Jesus said, "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in Heaven." (Matthew 5.16 NASB). Many think that means we are to shine brightly, and there is truth in that, for the light must be bright enough to be seen. But notice how the NASB brings out the nuance of what Jesus was saying . . . "in such a way . . ." If the church does not have a unified message and its members are not working together, its just a bunch of busy light noise, like a city. Perhaps you have driven past a city on the interstate after dark... all the lights vying for attention to the point that nothing is clear or distinct. But with a unified message, with genuine fellowship (working together) of the members, the message to the weary traveler is "here we are", just like the lights of the windfarm.

Is the message you are proclaiming with your life in sync with your fellow church members? Is it in sync with Christ and His gospel? Is your light shining in such a way that others see Jesus?

Missions Opportunity!

As part of the partnership between the Missouri Baptist Convention and the Minnesota-Wisconsin Baptist Convention, our missions committee is planning a mission trip to Rochester Minnesota for July 19 – 26. This mission opportunity involves helping the Emmanuel Baptist Church with Vacation Bible School, and also doing some work at the convention offices. There will be painting, removing vinyl flooring, installing ceramic tile, and some landscaping work. To accomplish all that needs to be done we will need at 15-20 people. Having someone accompany the group as a cook would be a great blessing and allow the other workers more time to do the painting and other work.

The trip is open to anyone who is at least 18 years old and a member of an LOBA church. Those under 18 may also participate as long as a parent or other responsible adult accompanies them.

Each person will be responsible for their own meals and transportation in-route to Rochester, but carpooling is encouraged. While on the field, we will have lodging in the facilities of the Emmanuel Baptist Church. Meals will be together as a team and the cost for groceries is \$75 per person with a maximum of \$150 per family.
