Many of us are accustomed to planning our days, weeks and even months. We will go to church on Sunday, go to work on Monday, go to the kid's school event on Thursday, mow the grass and visit the grandparents on Saturday.... Send the kids to camp this week, take a vacation that week, attend a friend's wedding 8 months from now....

Sure, we plan for contingencies. There may be a change of plans from time to time, a "bump in the road" on the way we have mapped out.
