Well, as everyone knows, the KC Chiefs won the Super Bowl this year! We had a youth watch party that night at FBC Eldon and it was a good event for the first three quarters – good food, new friends...but the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter got exciting!

There are some observations and reflections about the Super Bowl that I would like to share with you...

First, they had never done it this way before. True, they won the Super Bowl once – before it was even officially called the Super Bowl . . . 50 years ago! And there are many years when the Chiefs would have a great season, even make it to the playoffs, but they had not won the Super Bowl in 50 years.

This past season they did some things differently. Andy Reid knew that if they played like they had played in the past they would get the results they have gotten in the past. Mahomes was willing to do some things out of the ordinary. Kelce and others were there to support him and do their part. The same thing needs to happen in some churches . . . doing what we've always done will get us the same results we've always had — only as our culture changes it may get you worse results than in the past. If we want to win big in reaching people with the Gospel of Jesus, we must be willing to do things we have never done before. This is called faith. Doing what we've done before because it is comfortable and we know what results to anticipate is walking by sight, not walking by faith. Are you, and your church, willing to do things in a way you have never done them before?

Second, glory of man soon fades. It has been less than a month since the Super Bowl, and while people still talk of it and agree it was a great game and a great team, the excitement has faded from what is was on February 3<sup>rd</sup>. In fact, it is no longer part of our daily conversations. In a few more months we will be more focused on the Stanley Cup, or perhaps the World Series and this past Super Bowl will have faded from our memories even more. Whatever mankind accomplishes soon loses its luster. There is an old saying that would be wise for all of us to remember:

Only one life, 'twill soon be passed, only what's done for Christ will last. Are you pursuing the things of man and this world? Or are you pursuing the things of Christ?

Third, the world regards performance, but God rewards character. Are we striving to perform? To reach some unattainable goal and impress others....or even impress God? Or are we more interested seeking him and being faithful?

One final lesson from the Super Bowl – it was a team effort. Ministry is also a team effort. Camp is a team effort. Helping our Brother and Sisters in Minnesota is a team effort. Are you ready to be a part of the team?

## 2020 ON MISSIONS CELEBRATION

On October 11-14, missionaries will be in the Lake of the Ozarks Association and available to speak in our area Baptist Churches.

In order to participate in the On Missions Celebration your church needs to sign up to sponsor, or partner with another church to sponsor one of the missionaries who will speak at the sponsoring churches on a rotating basis starting at the sponsoring church on Sunday morning and then speaking at the other participating churches as assigned. All participating churches, or partnering churches, will have an opportunity to hear each missionary.

Services will be held Sunday morning, Sunday evening, Monday evening, Tuesday evening and Wednesday evening, five services.

Sponsoring churches, or churches that partner to sponsor a missionary will be responsible for providing the following:

- \$500.00 to the association to provide for transportation costs of the missionaries to and from LOBA and lodging costs while staying in LOBA.
- The sponsoring churches will also be responsible for the cost of meals for their missionary while they are here. Missionaries will provide receipts to their sponsoring church for meals eaten out. The church will then compensate their sponsored missionary for receipts received.
- The sponsoring church or partnering churches will be responsible for arranging transportation for their missionary from the motel to their assigned churches; Sunday morning through Wednesday evening.
- **◆** An offering is to be taken at each service. The money is <u>not</u> to be given to the missionary at that service but is to be remitted to the association office. It will then be equally divided among all participating missionaries. This is the only pay they will receive for their ministry to our association.
- There will be a contract for each sponsoring or partnering churches to sign that will be made available by the association office. The contract will specifically state the responsibilities of the sponsoring churches for their missionary. A signature and date of the business meeting at which the sponsoring church voted to participate in the On Mission Celebration will be required. We would like for the contracts to be signed in time for the April Executive Board Meeting, April 14, so that there can be a discussion of questions from participating churches.
