In Mark 16.15 Jesus instructs His followers to go into all the world and preach the gospel. It is impossible for any one person to do that, so churches have been sending missionaries since the day Antioch sent Paul and Barnabas out to preach the gospel. Over the years many have gone to the ends of the earth carrying the gospel of Jesus Christ.

In 1925 Southern Baptists adopted a plan for missionary support called the Cooperative Program. Through the Cooperative Program every person who gives to their local church can be a part of sharing the gospel to "all the world". As we give to our churches, our churches give to the Missouri Baptist Convention, and the MBC then passes funds on to the Southern Baptist Convention Offices in Nashville, where those funds are divided between the International Mission Board and the North American Mission Board, as well as our seminaries which train the missionaries, and a few other ministries.

This cooperation at the heart of the Cooperative Program is unique among Southern Baptists. There is no set fee that a church is required to give. No invoice or billing is ever sent out. The monies given to support missions is entirely voluntary, cooperative. But this system has been blessed by God to the extent that Southern Baptists have the largest missionary force ever assembled in the history of Christianity. Currently we support 3,613 missionaries around the globe.

The weakness in the Cooperative Program, according to some, is that it is "impersonal". There is no opportunity to get to know the missionaries in a face to face way, so they claim. But we here in the Lake of the Ozarks Baptist Association know this is not true! This month we are having yet another "On Mission Celebration"! From Sunday, October 11 through Wednesday, October 14 we will have 6 missionaries among us. In addition to Sunday morning they will be speaking every night, Sunday through Wednesday. A schedule of their speaking engagements is found elsewhere in this newsletter, so find a service you can attend and go hear what God is doing around the world. Learn how your gifts to the Cooperative Program through your local church is helping to fulfill the Great Commission.

While we are talking about missions giving, let me take this opportunity to say thank you to all of our churches who faithfully give to the association as well. Through your gifts to the Lake of the Ozarks Baptist Association we are able to support our summer missionaries, participate in missions opportunities in Minnesota, keep the block party trailer licensed, insured and maintained, assist churches with Vacation Bible School, provide training events for Deacons, Sunday School teachers, etc., support our disaster relief ministry, and do a variety of other ministry endeavors. Giving was short of budget this past year, but with some adjustments in spending we ended our fiscal year okay, and for that we are thankful. As we begin our new fiscal year, we hope to be able to accomplish what is necessary to fulfill all of the opportunities before us, so your continued faithfulness is greatly appreciated.
