

#### **Proclaim Jesus the Christ...**

In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." – 1 Corinthians 11:25-26 (NIV 2011)

These words should be familiar to you. If not, let me refresh your memory. Every time we celebrate the Lord's Supper, we recall this Scripture. Ah, yes, now it's striking the old memory cells. These were some of Jesus' last words to His disciples before He went to the cross for our sins. He gave them instructions to continue doing these things...eating of the bread, drinking of the cup, and therefore, proclaiming the Lord's death.

Help me chase a rabbit for just a second. Where was the emphasis to which Christ wanted us to place our focus? Was it the "doing" of drinking, eating or proclaiming? You see, Christians are pretty good at the first two. We really don't have a problem in keeping the ordinances. In fact, as Baptist we love to state that we have two ordinance, the Lord's Supper and Baptism. This way, we don't get hung up in all the legalism. However, in making statements like this, we may be missing what Christ was saying.

Jesus stated that the eating of bread and drinking of the cup were important, not in and of themselves, but because they pointed to the proclamation of the Lord's death and resurrection. Therefore, the emphasis of importance is the proclamation, not the drinking or the eating. We must quit taking the easy way out, stating that we are doing what Christ has told us to do, when we clearly are not. Sure, we are eating and drinking, remembering what He has done for us. However, can we honestly say that we are doing it in such a way that we are PROCLAIMING his death? And, if by chance you think we are, do you think we are do so, CONSISTENTLY? Remember, we exist for those that are not yet members. We exist to proclaim Jesus Christ!

## **Standing Rib Roast**

Recipe from www.tasteofhome.com Yield: 10 servings

Prep: 5 min Cook Time: 2 1/4 hours

#### **Ingredients:**

- · 3 teaspoons lemon-pepper seasoning
- · 3 teaspoons paprika
- · 1-1/2 teaspoons garlic salt
- 1 teaspoon dried rosemary, crushed
- · 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1 bone-in beef rib roast (6 to 7 pounds)
- 2 cups beef stock

#### **Directions**

- Preheat oven to 325°. In a small bowl, mix the first five ingredients. Place roast in a roasting pan, fat side up; rub with seasoning mixture.
- Roast 2-1/4 to 2-3/4 hours or until meat reaches desired doneness (for medium-rare, a thermometer should read 135°; medium, 140°; medium-well, 145°). Remove roast from oven; tent with foil. Let stand 15 minutes before carving.
- Meanwhile, pour drippings and loosened browned bits from roasting pan into a small saucepan.
   Skim fat. Add beef stock to drippings; bring to a boil. Serve with roast.
