Coming together by outdoing one another...

"Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves." Romans 12:10 (NIV 2011)

Paul gives the church of Rome sound advice as to how to live a Christian life. Most of us are familiar with Romans 12:1, where Paul reminds his audience that Christians are to present their bodies as a living sacrifice. In fact, I imagine most of us have heard a few sermons on this subject. As we move through the scripture a bit, stop at verse 10 where Paul encourages the reader to be devoted to one another in love. It's one thing to talk about what we do as an individual (v.1) and whole other thing to talk about what we do regarding others (v.10).

We are to love each other in brotherly love in a devoted manner. This is not to be a casual love, but one of devotion in good times and bad times; one with ups and downs; one with superficial and deep discussions. This type of relationship is one that develops over time; one that is forged through trials. Through these trials, love is kept at the center and is, therefore, the basis of the relationship.

The next phrase is really what caught my attention, however. "Honor one another above yourselves" seems fairly cut and dry. After all, if I make sure to place my brother in Christ above me, then I have been successful in this task...mission accomplished. If I have honored or valued them more than myself, haven't I done what I have been encouraged to do? Well, maybe! First, the task is to be done continually, there is no end to this task. In other words, we are to *always* make others feel more valuable than ourselves. This is an uncommon practice in today's society. Second, the English Standard Version (ESV) has a different interpretation that captures the meaning a little better I believe. The ESV reads, "...Outdo one another in showing honor." In other words, try to make sure that the other person always feels more important, more valuable.

It's a hard concept in today's world to think about building others up. We tend to want to talk about all we have accomplished, all that has happened to us, all that is going on in our lives. What would it look like if tried to outdo each other in a different way? If we were to show how valued the other person is to us? This might bring us together as a church, a community, and a nation!

Berries & Cream Torte

Prep time: 40 minutes Bake time: 10 min | Yield: 12 servings

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

FILLING:

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 4-1/2 teaspoons confectioners' sugar
- 4-1/2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 3 cups heavy whipping cream
- 4 cups sliced fresh strawberries
- 2 cups fresh blueberries
- 2 cups fresh raspberries
- In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Combine the flour, baking powder and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture.
- Line two baking sheets with parchment paper or greased aluminum foil; draw a 9-3/4-in. circle on each. Spoon a fourth of the batter onto each circle; spread evenly with a spoon to within 1/4 in. of edge. Bake at 350° for 8-10 minutes or until edges are golden brown. Remove to wire racks to cool completely. Repeat with remaining batter.
- Combine the sugar, confectioner's sugar and cornstarch. In a large bowl, beat cream and sugar mixture until stiff peaks form. To assemble, place one cookie layer on a large serving plate. Top with 1-1/2 cups whipped cream mixture and 2 cups of mixed berries. Repeat layers twice. Top with remaining cookie layer and whipped cream mixture. Arrange remaining berries on top. Cover and refrigerate for 4 hours.
